Case Study - Primary Education

Upper Primary – Edinbarnet Primary School, West Dunbartonshire

Project Overview

Pupils were initially familiarised with the software and then set the task of planning their own PE lesson using the software. Following this they were asked to present the lesson to their peers and explain the learning achievements required, deliver the lesson in practice and self evaluate and peer evaluate the lesson.

The software was also used as an IT and practical learning tool to reinforce 2d shapes, introduce different angles and create lessons on symmetry.
